Substrate Conditions

- ROCKCOTE Cerano must be applied over properly prepared substrates that are free of dirt, dust, grime and any other contaminants.
- Substrates must not contain more that 15% WME prior to application.
- Do not apply if air and surface temperatures are below 5°C or above 35°C.
- If applying over ROCKCOTE Quick Render, application may proceed after 48 hours if properly cured.
- Fresh cementitious substrates such as site mix sand and cement render and concrete must be left for up to 28 days to sufficiently cure prior to application of ROCKCOTE Cerano.
- ROCKCOTE Anti Efflorescent primer should be used when applying over site mix render.

Application

- Check colour before use.
- Ensure same batch numbers are used on a single wall where possible.
- Apply evenly over the properly prepared substrate with a brush, roller or trowel.
- Ideally apply slightly thicker than the granules to achieve optimum results.
- Finish with a steel or Venetian trowel.
- Be sure to keep a wet edge with this product and plan your work to suit the product and weather conditions.
- If joining up to previous day's application, it is "good working practice" to start and finish on an external or internal corner.
- Keep sheltered from rain & moisture for 24-48 hrs after completion dependent on climatic conditions.
- It is advisable to apply a primer that is tinted to the required finish colour before the application of ROCKCOTE Cerano.
- Over coat with 2 coats of ROCKCOTE Repel or ROCKCOTE Clearcote.

Precautions and Limitations

- Check colour before use.
- Ensure same batch numbers are used on a single wall where possible.
- Should not be applied in temperatures below 5°C or above 35°C.
- Not suitable for areas of continual damp or areas submerged in water.

Transport and Storage

- Store in a cool dark place
- Keep pail sealed
- Do not stack over 3 high

Disposal

• Dispose of in accordance with local council regulations
