Rockcote Systems carry a complete system warranty provided that it is applied as a complete system by experienced applicators that have the relevant skills and trade qualifications and strictly in accordance with Rockcote Technical and System specifications,

Before completing the warranty form, you will need to have the following information:

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- All project address details
- The name of each of the products used in the system including the painted finish colour
- Proof of Purchase – delivery dockets or invoices need to be attached to the Warranty Application
- Property Owner details (address and contact details)
- The builder is required to provide their Licence number (if applicable) and sign the Warranty Application (not required if refurbishment)
- The applicator to provide a Licence number (if applicable) and sign the Warranty Application
- The installer (if applicable) to provide a Licence number (if applicable) and sign the Warranty Application

The Warranty Application Form must be filled out in full, signed by the relevant tradespeople and returned to Rockcote within 3 months of the purchase of the System Components.

Your warranty will take approximately 5 working days to be processed.

A copy of the warranty will be sent to the property owner, as indicated on the Application Form, along with a Rockcote Maintenance Guide. If a second copy of the warranty is required to be sent to the warranty applicant, please indicate this on the Application Form.
