Colours and Gloss

Suitable for tinting to a wide range of natural colours, however, bright, highly saturated or "plastic-toned" paint colours may not be achievable.

Sheen Level: Matt

Coverage Rate: Approximately 2-5m² per 15L pail depending on thickness of application.

Coverage rates vary according to substrate, application technique, wastage factors and substrate preparation.

Substrate Conditions

- Substrate must be installed as per manufacturer's specifications.
- Substrate must be clean and free of dust, dirt, oil, salt, mould or any other contamination.
- Any base coats should be fully cured.
- Substrates must not contain more than 15% moisture prior to the application of Rockcote Clay Plaster Décor.

Mixing

- Mix well before use

Application

- Check colour prior to use to ensure consistency.
- Where possible, use products from the same batch on single wall to maintain colour consistency.
- Apply evenly over properly prepared substrate slightly thicker than the aggregate size to obtain desired finish.
- Finish using a plastic float or steel trowel.
- The application of Rockcote Natural Materials is a highly skilled process that requires experience working with natural building products and systems. It is the responsibility of the applicator to select the right materials for the job and ensure correct installation and application according to the guidelines in the Rockcote Natural Materials Systems Guide and the attached specification. Rockcote strongly recommends that all Rockcote Natural Materials be applied by a licensed tradesperson who has extensive experience in applying the product for a similar application to the project at hand. Rockcote is not responsible for the ongoing maintenance of the Natural Material finishes, which is required in the upkeep and performance of the coating.

Precautions and Limitations

- Check colour before use.
- Internal use only.
- Ensure same batch numbers are used on a single wall where possible.
- Should not be applied in temperatures below 5°C or above 35°C.
- Not suitable for areas of continual damp or areas submerged in water.
- Apply evenly over a properly prepared substrate.
- Not suitable for areas of continual damp or areas submerged in water.

Transport and Storage

- Store in a cool dark place.
- Keep pail sealed.
- Do not stack over 3 high.

Disposal

- Dispose of in accordance with local council regulations
